Competitors may enter both "5x5" and "3x3".

Active competitors from police, fire and relevant first responder agencies may combine to form a team regardless of agency size **WITHIN A COUNTRY**. Retired competitors may combine to form a team in any manner they wish with other eligible competitors whether police or fire. This includes across country lines.

**Sport Equipment** Each team is responsible for bringing their own practise balls

All competitors must wear a team uniform. Uniform shirts must be numbered and identical in color. Each team must have two different colored uniform shirts available.

## Competition Format

### Bracketing

A Round Robin tournament followed by a double elimination tournament.

### Scheduling

Scheduled for 4 days of competition. See [Sport Schedule](#) for details.

**There is a 10-minute forfeit rule in effect. Forfeited games will be recorded as 21-0 to the opposing team.**

### Awards

Medals are awarded First through Third Place (1st – 3rd).

## Sport Rules

Players are not excluded based on the number of personal fouls. A player shall be disqualified for the remainder of the game when he is charged with 2 unsportsmanlike fouls. A player disqualified from the game may be further disqualified from the event by the WPFGE depending on how blatant and intentional the foul was at the time it was committed

A team losing by default, or a tortuous forfeit may be disqualified from the competition. However, the Incident Review Committee for the WPFGE must weigh

in on the disqualification before it can be final.

Each team shall designate an individual to function as the team captain for each game. If the team has a sworn Non-Playing Coach, that person may be the Team Captain.

*\*WPFG follows FIBA's Official Basketball Rules. Some rules may slightly differ from FIBA rules such as the number of players allowed on a team.*

*The WPFGF is the overall governing body of this event and may add/delete rules at its discretion.*

### **Pre-Competition Meeting**

Prior to each team's first game at the start of competition, a meeting shall be held between the referee and the captain or coach of each participating team to verify the rules of play and conduct.

### **Players Conduct**

Any serious violation of conduct, such as fighting or violence toward players or officials, will result in the player(s) immediate ejection from that game and his/her automatic suspension from his/her team's next scheduled game. The Sport Coordinator will immediately notify the WPFGF, who will investigate each incident to determine if additional discipline will be imposed.
