Practise

August 3rd is the practice day for athletes to familiarise themselves with the course. There will be officials, volunteers, and medical present from **13:00-16:00** for the designated practice time. Outside of the practice time, athletes can ride at their own risk. It will be the responsibility of the athlete to find their own way to the venue on the practice day.

Competition Schedule

- The first heat will begin at 9am on August 4th
- The race will take approximately 1-1.5 hours for each heat.
- One lap of the course is 5.07 km (3.15 miles)
- All athletes will complete a total of 5 laps of the course

Sport Equipment

Riders must wear a securely fastened helmet, fully enclosed footwear, and the appropriate attire including a shirt. Riders shall use a bicycle with two working gears, and ensure that handlebars are covered for safety reasons.



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Please note: competitors are required to provide their own bikes for competition. Bikes rentals are in short supply in Winnipeg and surrounding areas.

Additional Sport Information

As the Host Society, we have the ability to transport bikes via trailers for the competition day. There are a total of 50 spaces available for bikes. Trailers will be aligned with the bus schedule to the venue. Athletes are responsible for fastening and securing their own bikes, and volunteers will be available to assist as needed.

There is limited space available so this service will be on a first come first serve basis. Please email cyclingmountain@wpfg2023.com with the subject line **Cycling Trailer**, and in the email include your name, home country, and agency if you wish to use this service. If there is no space on the trailer, we will let you know ASAP.

Note: trailers will only be available on race day August 4th.

Transportation

Parking

There is no available parking at Bison Butte There is available parking at the Fort Whyte Alive Center (1961 McCreary Rd) and/or Cabela's (581 Sterling Lyon Pkwy). The mountain biking course is then accessible by foot or bike from those two locations.
