



## 2025 US Police & Fire Championships Bowling

Welcome to the United States Police & Fire Championships. This letter serves as your Final Confirmation of your participation in Bowling. Bowling is scheduled for Tuesday June 3rd through Thursday, June 5<sup>th</sup> at Mira Mesa Lanes, [8210 Mira Mesa Blvd, San Diego, CA 92126](https://www.marriott.com/hotels-and-hotels/mira-mesa-lanes-bowling-center). The Guiding Bodies are the United States Police & Fire Championships and the United States Bowling Congress Rules. USBC Rules will be used unless there is a conflicting USPFC Rule.

### Conduct Expected of ALL Participants:

Drinking of alcoholic beverages, unlawful consumption of controlled substances, and gambling is prohibited while competing. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be condoned either before, during, or after competition. Any physical or verbal assaults on officials, competitors, spectators, coordinators or venue staff will be met with **IMMEDIATE AND SEVERE PENALTIES**, including **EXPULSION** from these and future United States Police & Fire Championships.

Each athlete must go in person to the Accreditation Center located at the Marriott Mission Valley. 8757 Rio San Diego Dr, San Diego, CA 92108 prior to their events. **AGENCY IDENTIFICATION REQUIRED.**

### Competition:

Check in will begin at 10:30 am at the Mira Mesa Lanes Final practice will start at 10:50am. The tournament will begin at 11:00am

Bowling consists of four events: Singles, Doubles, and Teams, plus an overall category of "All Events" (in which you must enter **Singles, Doubles and Team**) to qualify. In addition, the Top Five bowlers from the "All-Events" division will be invited to a PBA-style Roll-Off to determine the top five bowlers.

There will be 3 skill divisions:

- **Open Division:** All bowlers having a league average of 190 or over as of May 31st of the year of competition will bowl Open Division. Men bowlers without league averages will bowl Open Division for Singles and All Events. A 200 average will be used for placement in Team and Doubles events.
- **"A" Division:** All bowlers with league averages of 170 up to, and including, 189 as of May 31st of the year of competition will bowl "A" Division. Women bowlers without league averages will bowl "A" Division for Singles and All Events. A 189 average will be used for placement in Team and Doubles events.
- **"B" Division:** All bowlers with league averages of 169 and below as of May 31<sup>st</sup> of the year of competition will bowl "B" Division.

Bowlers will be scheduled to bowl only one event each day. Exception: A bowler may request an exception to avoid schedule conflicts with other events. The bowling coordinator may grant that request if it does not pose any scheduling problems in bowling.

Teams are comprised of four (4) bowlers. Four (4) bowlers must enter the Team event in order for the team to be considered eligible.

If a Team bowler or Doubles bowler is late or unable to show, the bowlers present may bowl. A score of zero (0) will be taken for each frame the absent bowler misses. No other blind scores will be used. (This will allow the other bowlers to have a chance in "All Events" when a team member doesn't show.)
