



## 2025 US Police & Fire Championships Cycling-Street

Welcome to the United States Police & Fire Championships. This letter serves as your Final Confirmation of your participation in Cycling-Street. Cycling-Street is scheduled for Saturday, May 31, through Wednesday, June 3, in San Diego, CA. Locations are listed below. The Guiding Bodies are the United States Police & Fire Championships and the United States Cycling Federation (USCF).

### Registration:

This event offers onsite registration each morning beginning at 0730 hours. All events will begin at 0900. You will be issued your bib number, timing chip, etc. at that time. **AGENCY IDENTIFICATION REQUIRED.**

**Criterion:** May 31, 2025, Woodward Avenue and Broadway, Escondido, CA. 92025

**Road Race:** June 2, 2025, East Valley Parkway and Beven Drive, Escondido, CA. 92027

**Hill Climb:** June 1, 2025, Deer Springs Road and Champagne Blvd., Escondido, CA. 92026

**Time Trials:** June 3, 2025, Richmond Road and Mulberry Drive, San Marcos, CA. 92069

**Sprints:** May 31, 2025, Woodward Avenue and Broadway, Escondido, CA. 92025

Saturday, May 31 -- **Criterion and Sprints.** Woodward Avenue and Broadway, Escondido

First Criterion race at 0800 hours. Course is 9/10th mile, flat, four corners. Races are 35 minutes plus 5 laps.

Depending on number of racers, we will either have 2 or 3 races.

Sprints held one hour after last criterium. Course is straight and flat, approximately 320 meters. Placing based on total score of three heats: 5 points for 1st, 3 points for 2nd, one point for 3rd.

Sunday, June 1 -- **Hill Climb.** Deer Springs Road and Champagne Blvd, Escondido - 0800 hours

Course is 2.7 miles, 630 feet of elevation gain. Grade varies from 3% to 8%.

Monday, June 2 -- **Road Race.** East Valley Pkwy and Beven Drive, Escondido

Race starts at 1000 hours. Course is 27 miles, 1,900 feet of climbing. Neutral start of 4.5 miles along East Valley Pkwy and El Norte Pkwy. Race underway at northbound Centre City Pkwy just north of El Norte Pkwy. Aid/water station at approximately the halfway point.

Tuesday, June 3 -- **Time Trial.** Richland Road and Mulberry Drive, San Marcos.

First rider off at 0800 hours. One-minute interval between riders. Course is five laps of 2-mile, 4-corner circuit, mostly flat. Total race distance 10 miles.

Note: Since this course is a point to point, riders will be responsible for safely returning to the parking/check in area upon completing the course

Start times: Will be posted on the USPFC website at least one week in advance. Every effort will be made to place late entries on the start list by the event coordinator before the day of the event. The final start list will be posted in the check in area. Please verify your start time when you arrive at the event.
