Any physical or verbal assaults on officials, competitors, spectators, coordinators or ex-officios will be met **with IMMEDIATE AND SEVERE PENALTIES**, including **EXPULSION** from these and future United States Police & Fire Championships.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

There is a **MANDATORY** Team Captain's meeting on Monday, June 2nd at the venue 1 hour prior to your team's first game. Each team **MUST** have at least one (1) representative present at this meeting. It is the Captain's responsibility to make sure that every player on their roster is an eligible player. It is the Captain's responsibility to ensure that all team members know the rules of play.

BRACKETING

Pool play – Round Robin followed by a Playoff.

This sport features bracketed and scheduled competition held over more than one day. Scheduling information will be available at Host Headquarters when you Register; and can be seen on the Ice Hockey Homepage on the USPFC website.

GENERAL RULES

A team may consist of a maximum of 20 persons (18 players and 2 goalkeepers), plus one Non-Playing Coach.

IMPORTANT: All teams and personal equipment, including uniforms and sticks, will be supplied by the individual competitor and shall comply with the safety requirements as specified in the USA Hockey Rulebook. Pucks will be provided for pre-game warm-ups.

All required safety equipment, including helmets, must be worn in accordance with the USA Hockey rules. The USPFC strongly recommends the use of face shields.

All players on a team will wear similar jerseys with individual numbers on the back. Each team must be equipped with dark and light (home and away) jerseys for all players. Please send team roster, with jersey numbers, to Mark Graham no later than Friday, June 3rd.

No "body checking" is permitted in any division.

Fighting will not be tolerated and will result in expulsion from the remainder of the tournament and possible expulsion from future United States Police & Fire Championships.
