Welcome to the United States Police & Fire Championships. This letter serves as your Final Confirmation of your participation in Soccer-Outdoor. Soccer-Outdoor is scheduled for Monday, June 2nd through Friday, June 6th at Town Center Community Park- 550 Park Center Dr., Santee, CA 92071.

Schedule of Play: Men's Open 18+ and 35+, will begin on Monday, June 2nd. Women's 18+ will begin on Tuesday, June 3rd. All events will be completed on Friday, June 6th, with medals awarded to the winning teams.

The Guiding Bodies are the United States Police & Fire Championships and the Federation Internationale de Futbol Association (FIFA).

Conduct Expected of ALL Participants:

Drinking of alcoholic beverages, unlawful consumption of controlled substances, and gambling is prohibited while competing. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be condoned either before, during, or after competition. Any physical or verbal assaults on officials, competitors, spectators, coordinators or ex-officios will be met **with IMMEDIATE AND SEVERE PENALTIES**, including **EXPULSION** from these and future United States Police & Fire Championships.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

There is a **MANDATORY** Team Captain's meeting for both men divisions will be on Sunday, June 1st at 4:00 PM, in the Salon E in Rio Vista Ballroom at the Marriott Mission Valley, 8757 Rio San Diego Dr, San Diego, CA 92108. Women's team captain meeting will be on Tuesday, June 3rd, at the Santee Town Center, one hour prior to the first game of the tournament. Only one (1) representative from each team will be allowed in this meeting. It is the responsibility of the Team Captain to disseminate all information to their team members. Captains must immediately notify the Sports Director if there are any errors in the participant information. Captains are responsible for making sure that every player on their roster has paid the appropriate entry fee and is an eligible player.

DIVISIONS:

Team Events:

Men's Open 18+

Men's 35+

Women's Open 18+

BRACKETING:

All men's teams will compete in a Round Robin. The two top teams from each pool will advance to a Single Elimination tournament which will determine the medal winners. **The placement of teams into the tournament will be based on a random draw and not on point differential within a pool.**

The women's division will be a round robin with the results of those games determining the medal placements.

SPORT RULES:

Substitutions shall be unlimited and may be made, with the consent of the referee, at any stoppage in play.

A player may compete on only one team and in only one division.

Duration of Game: All games will be two 35-minute halves, both the round robin and the single elimination tournament, due to the number of consecutive days of competition. Player safety and well-being is of the utmost importance. All ties in group play will be immediately followed by penalty kicks. In the event of a tie in the Single Elimination Finals tournament, the winner will be determined by Kicks from the Penalty Mark, except for the medal rounds. During the medal rounds, extra time will be played to determine the winner. Two further equal periods, each of 10 minutes duration, will be played. If teams are still tied after the extra time the winner will be determined by Kicks from the Penalty Mark.

Dress of players shall be consistent with FIFA and USPFC Rules. No grid-iron shoes.
