When completed, this questionnaire will assist the World Police and Fire Games Federation (Federation) in selecting the Host candidates that will be invited to continue in the selection process for the 2031 World Police and Fire Games (Games). Continuation in the selection process includes: a Site Inspection that includes a visit to the Host candidate city to review sports venues; a meeting with the Host candidate representatives and government/community officials; an inspection of the Host candidate hotel and the convention center to evaluate the Host candidate's ability to conduct the Games.

The Site Inspection Committee is comprised of no more than five (5) Federation Representatives.

A successful Site Inspection will result in an invitation to submit a bid proposal which includes an in-person bid presentation made before the full Federation Board in Ahmedabad, India in October, 2027.

- The term "City", includes the immediate city plus surrounding metropolitan areas;
- The term "Games" refers to World Police and Fire Games;
- If appropriate, answer questions based on the assumption that your city has been selected to Host the 2031 World Police and Fire Games.
